On behalf of the *New Jersey Psychological Association's Division of Academic & Scientific Affairs*, you are invited to submit proposals of your scholarly work for NJPA's poster hall section of the **Fall 2020 virtual conference**. Submissions should discuss research (for example, psychological research, clinical research, applied research etc.) that has not been presented or published elsewhere. All submissions will be reviewed and evaluated by a review committee. NJPA membership by poster authors is highly encouraged.

**All approved poster authors' poster presentations will be part of the 2020 NJPA Virtual Fall Conference. Presenters will be expected to be available for both recorded and live virtual presentations.**

**Presentation Format**

- Presenters will be expected to submit:
  - An electronic copy of their poster (Due September 1, 2020)
  - A 2-min video discussion of their project (Due September 1, 2020).
- This information will be made available for conference attendees and presenters will be expected to be available during the virtual poster session to answer any questions about their research.

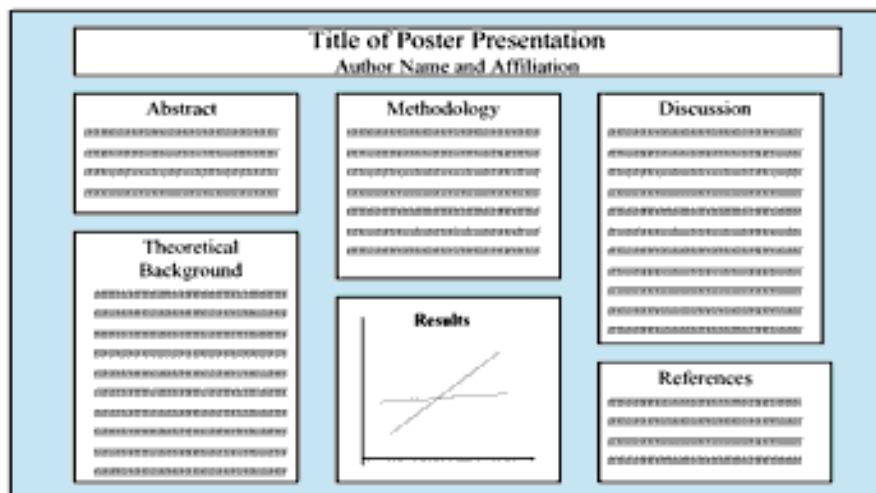
