Approved poster presenters are expected to submit a final 1-min narrated electronic video poster presentation by September 1, 2021. Conference attendees can expect poster presentations to be available to view online in the 2021 Poster Hall section of the NJPA Fall Conference Website by the end of September.

All approved poster authors' poster presentations will be part of the 2021 NJPA Virtual Fall Conference and may be used by NJPA in articles and other media for other audiences in the future. Poster authors will be expected to be available during a virtual poster session of the Fall Conference to answer questions and discuss their research.

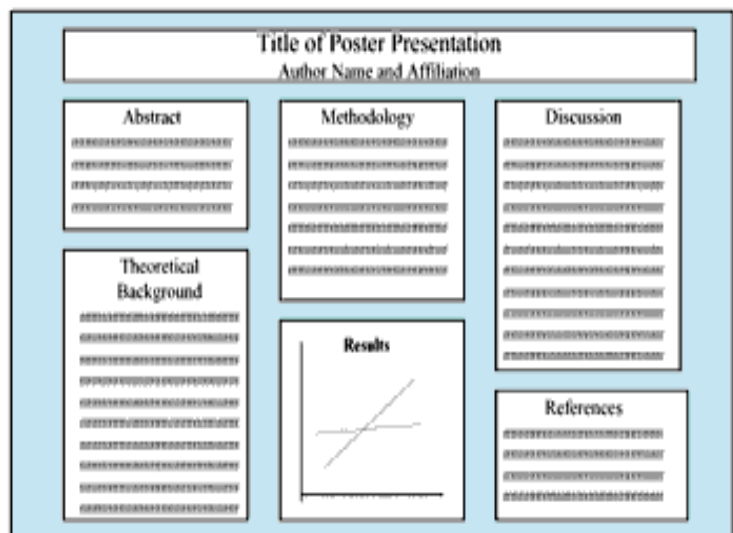
