

## **NJPA Jurisprudence Examination Overview Training - Under Construction**

*NJPA is currently reviewing our Jurisprudence Examination Overview training program. Any NJPA Jurisprudence Examination Overview training is intended as a resource tool only, and not a substitution for individuals' obligation to know the New Jersey statutes and regulations relevant to the practice of psychology.*

### **2021 Jurisprudence Exam Update**

1. For the online Jurisprudence Examination, the candidates will need technology access, including a camera for visual access. The examination will be virtually proctored. Instructions will be sent out when scheduled.
2. The (online) Jurisprudence Examination started in December 2020 will be available to a small group of 4-5 candidates in order of eligibility. The candidates' group frequency and size will grow as the examination scheduling moves forward. **As of January 22, 2021, 40 examination appointments have been scheduled and notifications have been sent, and 28 examination appointments have yet to be scheduled. The exam has been scheduled for applicants through March 26, 2021. Notices have been sent for slots through February, 12, 2021. The rest of February and March 2021 notifications are will be sent out at least 4 weeks in advance.**
3. The examination applicants will be notified via email. Candidates will be given at least **4 weeks** to prepare.
4. The examination has not changed. The exam is 25 question, true and false, and open book. The exam is 2 hours. The appointment letter will have this information included.
5. You can begin studying now, and the subject matter for the examination will be the BoPE regulations and statutes which can be found here - <https://www.njconsumeraffairs.gov/psy/Pages/regulations.aspx>
